Chef Mia's Chunky Lindt Chocolate Cookies

1 cup unsalted butter, room temperature
 1 cup light brown sugar
 1/2 cup white sugar
 1 tsp vanilla
 1/2 tsp salt
 1/2 tsp cinnamon
 Dash ground cardamon (optional)

2 large eggs

2 1/2 cups all purpose flour, sifted
 1 tsp baking soda, sifted

2 cups Lindt chocolate chunks (you can buy 300g bars of Lindt chocolate in the candy aisle)

Pre-heat convection oven to 350F (375F for non convection)

Use a wooden spoon and a bowl or use a stand up mixer with a paddle attachment to mix the butter, brown sugar, white sugar, vanilla, salt, cinnamon & cardamon until well combined.

Add the eggs & mix well, incorporating all the egg into the mixture.

Stir in the flour, baking soda and the Lindt chocolate chunks until it looks like cookie dough. Eat a small piece.

Scoop the cookie dough onto parchment paper lined cookie trays. Leave some space for cookies to expand while baking. A small ice cream scoop works well for this.

Place tray in the pre-heated oven and bake cookies 8 - 12 minutes or until the edges are golden and lightly browned.

Enjoy with milk - dunking allowed :)

Makes 2-3 dozen cookies.
